## IMPORTANT DETAILS BELOW REGARDING ALL YMCA YOUTH SOCCER

Dear Soccer Parent,

In an effort to provide the most age appropriate development possible for each child, our fall soccer programs are outlined as follows:

**Age as of July 31, 2010 determines which age group to play**

### **In house Recreation—YMCA Fields**

**U6—**  SPOSOCER ( 4 and 5 year olds)

Training: Team practices will be held Monday through Friday pending coaches choice of nights. Games: Game format will be 4 v 4 or 5 v 5 no goalie, depending on registration numbers. Games will be on Sundays and will be overseen by volunteer Coaches.

**U8 -**  SPOSOCER (6 and 7 year olds)

Training: .Team practices will be held Monday through Friday pending coaches choice of nights. Games: Game format will be 5 v 5 or 6 v 6 with a goalie, depending on registration numbers. Games will be on Sundays and will be overseen by volunteer Coaches.

**U10-**  SPOSOCER ( 8 and 9 year olds)

Training: Practices will be held at volunteer coaches preference of day. Games, 7 v 7, will be played on Sunday with an occasional Saturday game, within the Washington county league.

**RECREATIONAL TRAVEL- Frederick County Soccer League—Uniform and Dues for Soccer will run each player approximately \$40 dollars, Less if uniform still fits. Teams will be put together after the 17th, of July. Players will be contacted for a play-day.**

**U-10-**  SPOTRAVEL ( 8 and 9 year olds)

**Games:** Teams will play 7 v 7 within the Frederick County Leagues. **Games** are played against other Washington and Frederick county teams and are managed by the Team Coach on Saturdays, some Sunday games are required. Travel players will need a uniform and dues paid separately. Practices will be Coaches choice of nights.

**U12-**  SPOTRAVEL ( 10 and 11 year olds)

**Games:** Teams will play 8 v 8 within the Washington County or Frederick County Leagues. Games are played against other Washington and Frederick county teams and are managed by the Team Coach on Saturdays, some Sunday games are required. Travel players will need uniform and dues paid separately. Practices will be at coaches choice of nights.

**U14-**  SPOTRAVEL ( 12 and 13 year olds)

**Games:** Teams will play 11 v 11 within the Washington County or Frederick County Recreation Leagues. Games are generally Saturdays with some Sunday games required, managed by a Team Coach. Travel players will need uniform and dues paid separately. Practices will be at coaches choice of nights.

## **Things You Should Know About YMCA Programs**

### **What is a YMCA Program**

The YMCA Programs are offered to teach your child the basic skills of the individual program. These skills will consist of basic, intermediate, and advanced instruction where appropriate. All YMCA program participants shall participate, and play an equal amount of playing time, with the exception of our travel leagues, where playing time is determined by our Coaching staff. YMCA programs run with the benefit of Volunteers, without them our programs would not be possible to offer. There are always volunteer opportunities. In addition to paid staff the YMCA may utilize other adult or student volunteers and to enhance the programs performance. Student volunteers are young people, age 14-15, providing additional hands during practices and games while earning Service Learning Hours for graduation. YMCA volunteers are required to be screened before becoming involved with our programs.

### **Registration**

In order to maintain proper participant to Coach ratios, registration is required. Registration Fees vary depending on the program, and are required to be paid prior to the start of the program.

### **Custody of a Child**

The YMCA does not assume custody of your child. The YMCA staff provides only general supervision and monitoring of Program activities. The YMCA is not responsible for, and is not liable as participants come and go from our programs. We recommend that you drop off and pick up your child for safety reasons, and stay whenever possible.

### **.Size of Groups**

It is the YMCA goal to have all of our programs organized so that maximum participation and learning will be provided to your child. Therefore team numbers and participant spaces can be limited. Please register on time and the YMCA will make every effort to get your child off any waiting lists.

### **Hours of Operation**

Practices for sports programs are generally 1 hour in length in the evenings and games on Saturday or Sunday. Our other programs generally run for 45 minutes to an hour and stick to there scheduled times.

### **Arrival and Dismissal**

In order for schedules and organized activities to be met Children are asked to arrive at program 5 minutes early, helping everyone maintain there schedules.

### **Health Procedures**

To help promote a healthy environment for all children, sick children should remain home. Please do not bring your child to a program if he/she is showing signs or symptoms of illness. If we notice any symptoms while your child is attending, we will call you to arrange to have him/her picked up.

### **Medications**

The YMCA program staff is aware that many children are on different medications. Please make sure to place any and all pertinent medical information on the registration form, so that our Staff and Volunteers can be aware of any potential symptoms and or corrections that may need to be made.

### **Accidents/Injury**

In the event of an accident, appropriate procedures will be followed and parents will be notified. Reports are kept on all accidents and copies are released to the parent upon picking up the child. If we can not reach you, the child will be taken to the nearest emergency medical treatment facility. The cost of medical treatment is the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

### **Reporting Suspected Child Abuse/Neglect**

According to Maryland State Law, any camp employee is mandated to report any suspected child abuse and/or neglect to Social Services. The YMCA is not required by law to notify the parent(s) or guardian(s) before contacting Social Services. Failure to pick up a child by the end of the program activity can be considered neglect.

**Waiver of Liability:** By my signature below, I acknowledge that there are inherent risks and dangers associated with camp and recreation program(s) and therefore, I understand that the YMCA of Hagerstown, Maryland, Inc. (YMCA) assumes no responsibility for injuries which I, my spouse/partner, or my/our minor children may sustain as a result of my/their physical condition, my/their use of any facilities, or my/their participation in any activities, programs, exercise, or use of equipment. I acknowledge on behalf of myself, my spouse/partner, and my /our minor children and or heirs that I assume the risk of any and all injuries, illness, death, loss of damage which may result from any of the foregoing. I hereby release and discharge the YMCA, its agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims for injury, illness, death, and loss of damage which I, my spouse/partner, or minor children may suffer as a result of my/their physical condition, or improper use of equipment, this program, the use of any facility or participation in activities.

**Media Release:** I give permission to the YMCA of Hagerstown, Maryland, Inc. (YMCA) to use indefinitely, without limitation or obligation, photos, slides, film footage, or video recordings which may include my, my spouse/partner or, my/our minor children's image or voice for purpose of promoting or interpreting the YMCA and it's programs. If I prefer to not allow my, my spouse/partner or the above registered individual(s) images be utilized, I will provide in writing a notarized request within 10 days of this registration.

**Discipline Policy:** Discipline is handled in a positive manner that is consistent with the developmental needs of the individual child. Clear behavioral limits are set, and reasons for rules and regulations are explained. We expect children to have self-control and to handle conflicts in peaceful ways. If necessary, a brief "timeout" allows a child/group to regain composure, reflect upon negative behavior and to formulate, along with the help of a staff member, a more appropriate form of action.

In the case of continued discipline problems the following action shall be taken:

1. Verbal Reminder to the Child – A verbal reminder will state the rule that has been broken and the consequences of breaking the rule.
2. Timeout – After two (2) consecutive verbal reminders, a timeout shall be age-appropriate and no longer than ten (10) minutes.
3. Written Communication to Parent – If timeouts are not effective and infractions of rules continue a written notice will be sent to the parent(s)/guardian(s) by the Program Director, along with another copy of the Discipline Policy. This notice will state the problem, the actions taken by our staff and what we expect the parents to do.
4. Parent Conference – A parent conference will be held after steps one through three have been taken and the problem still has not been resolved. A written plan of action between the parent and staff will be formulated and agreed. In serious rules infractions of verbal abuse or threatening harm a parent conference may be call without step 1-3.
5. Dismissal From Program – written notification of immediate dismissal from the program by the Program Director will be sent if problems continue and all avenues are exhausted. In the case of physical or threatening harm to staff or another participant, results in the immediate suspension from the program.

I understand that if my/our minor children are dismissed from the program any and all fees paid will not be refunded.

**Loss/Damage of Personal Property:** I understand that the YMCA of Hagerstown, Maryland, Inc. (YMCA) is not responsible for personal property lost or stolen while I, my spouse/partner or my/our minor children are using the YMCA or other facilities/property used by the YMCA. It is my responsibility to notify the YMCA of any incidents and contact the police myself to report and stolen property or damage. It is further agreed that I, my spouse/partner will assume full responsibility for all damage done by the registered participant to the property of the YMCA, vendors or other participants.

I have read and acknowledge the waivers and conditions set forth in the Camp Registration and I am in agreement with the terms and conditions.
